We are delighted to announce that, in February, Wandsworth Council approved our detailed plans for the new hospital buildings at Springfield University Hospital. This is a significant milestone, which will provide the Trust with the necessary foundations to continue delivering the highest standards of care, benefiting patients in the borough and across South West London.

The new hospital, which is a key part of the wider regeneration at Springfield, will be delivered in two buildings to the rear of the Grade II Listed Main Building and link with the existing Storey building which houses three acute mental health wards.

The start of 2018 also marked the Trust's annual Quality Awards, which celebrate our staff and the fantastic work they do on a daily basis to deliver the best possible services to the 1.1m people we serve in South West London. We are committed to keep our neighbours and the wider community updated as the Estate Modernisation Programme progresses and move towards transforming mental health services in South West London.

Detailed plans submitted for Springfield Park

We are pleased to confirm that following a three-day public consultation in January 2018, our preferred development partner STEP has now submitted a planning application to Wandsworth Council with the detailed plans for Springfield Park and the associated public realm and roads around the Springfield University Hospital site, which is being referred to as Springfield Village.

The plans for Springfield Park follow the principles established by the approved Park Strategy, which was informed by over 80 hours of direct engagement and 1,900 responses from stakeholders, local community groups, service users and residents.

We would like to thank everyone who visited the consultation events and took the opportunity to provide their feedback on the plans. The project team has spent considerable time reviewing all feedback received and, where possible, this has been incorporated into the submitted plans.

- Two new sympathetically designed hospital buildings to provide state-of-the-art mental healthcare facilities.
- High levels of natural light, different materials and architectural styles to provide a varied environment.
- New wards featuring large communal spaces with dining and day areas which aim to promote a therapeutic, light and airy environment.
- New retail space at ground level, facing onto Chapel Square to provide activity in the square and amenities for patients and residents in the new homes.
- Car and cycle parking spaces for staff and visitors.
